	IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(6)	<ol> <li>With respect to any individual over whom the board has jurisdiction.</li> <li>To receive information concerning the individual's alleged misconduct; and</li> <li>To discuss, prior to any determination, that individual's status as an employee, student, independent contractor who is a physician or a school bus driver.</li> </ol>

	IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(8)	To discuss before any placement decision an individual student's abilities, past performances, behavior and needs.
	IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(9)	To discuss a job performance evaluation of individual employees.
	IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(10)	When considering the appointment of a public official (not an employee), to: develop a list of perspective appointees, consider application, and make one initial exclusion of prospective appointees from further consideration.
	IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(11)	To train board members with an outside consultant about the performance of their role as public officials.
	IC 5-14-1.5-6.1(b)(12)	To prepare or score examinations used in issuing license, certificates, permits or registrations.
