We continue to collect **donations for senior class recognition**. A fund for donations is available through the Mooresville Schools Educational Foundation Fund at the Community Foundation of Morgan County, a registered 501©3. Funds raised will help with the cost of yard signs for every class member, a permanent Class of 2020 item for the MHS campus, and recognition events if we are able to host in-person events. Funds may also be used toward assistance for students who may not be able to afford caps and gowns, senior photos, or other needed items.

We plan to have the Saturday morning date in July for the **Commencement Ceremony** finalized and communicated next week. Though we hope an in-person will be possible, we will plan a virtual ceremony in case restrictions do not allow that. If we have an in-person ceremony, we will livestream it like we did athletic events. An in-person ceremony will also have restrictions on the number of guests per student based upon the government guidelines and the size of our facility. Please contact me if you

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cannot participate in a July graduation ceremony because of your postsecondary plans (e.g. basic training). Once we know who these individuals are, we will develop a plan to recognize you.
