Families who live outside Brown, Madison and Harrison townships but are interested in enrolling their students at Mooresville Schools may enroll online now.


The out-of-distrct enrollment process is open through May 27. After that time, buildings or grade levels which are full will close to out-of-district enrollments.



#### **COVID Test Kits Available**

All Mooresville schools have received a supply of COVID-19 home test kits (each kit is a 4-pack of testing supplies) from the Indiana Department of Health (IDOH). These are available free of charge, one per household. For families who would like test kits, a parent/guardian will need to come pick up the kit. They will not be sent home with students.

The tests are marked to expire in July or August 2022, but that date will likely be extended. Please do not discard the tests based on stated expiration date before checking for expiration extension. Please check the IDOH website under Back to School Resources to determine if the expiration date has been extended before discarding based on the date on the box.
