

Opening After School Activities

As health department COVID-19 restrictions loosen, district administrators are working to move activities closer to pre-COVID standards.

Honoring a Legacy

Dr. William Roberson, Mooresville School Board President, was honored at Tuesday's school board meeting for a legacy that began when he was Mooresville's school superintendent (1994-2002). During that time, he created the "Our Kids - Our Future" motto and logo which endures today. Dr. Roberson was given a miniature of the first logo plaque which hung in the Superintendent's Office at the time. The

The Mooresville School Board has announced that Nikki Moore will be the next principal of Neil A. Armstrong Elementary School.

"Nikki Moore started as a strong teacher at Mooresville and moved into a role as a dynamic administrator," said Superintendent Randy Taylor. "We know that she'll continue to do great things leading Neil Armstrong Elementary."

Moore has been with Mooresville Schools for 19 years and currently serves as the assistant principal of Neil Armstrong and North Madison elementary schools.
