

# **Preparing for Little Pioneers Preschool**

Registration is open for the 2022-23 Little Pioneers Preschool program. The all-day program is designed to prepare students for kindergarten academics as well as instill a love of learning, through academically-focused and play-based activities. Preschool is open to children who have turned 4 before August 1 and who are potty-trained.

The Little Pioneers program currently takes place at Waverly Elementary School. If enough students enroll, a second preschool will also be held at Neil Armstrong. The sign-up period will be open through Friday, April 29, with students admitted on a first-come, first-served basis based. Parents will be notified in early May if their child has been admitted or placed on the waiting list.


