



# Upcoming Closures Will Affect Buses

Two different road projects will create new traffic patterns that affect school bus routes in the Mooresville area.

Beginning April 4, the Indiana Department of Transportation will re-start the High Street/State Road



42 project in Mooresville. Traffic throughout Mooresville will be slowed during this construction project, which could affect times for all buses arriving at and leaving MHS/PHMS. Please be aware route times may change slightly, especially in the first few days of the closure as traffic adjusts.

The first 150 kindergarten students in attendance will get a "Class of 2035" shirt! <u>Learn more here.</u>



### **Road Closures**

**Phase 4** - High St. will be closed from Main St. to Madison St. from Monday, April 4 until approximately the end of July

**Phase 5** - High St. will be closed from Madison St. to South St. from August through October 15.

As part of the I-69 Finish Line project near Waverly, Huggin Hollow Road has been realigned near the Circle K and BP gas stations. It will be the detour when Old SR 37 and Wellington Drive close north of SR 144 for roundabout construction, which is expected to begin next week. Watch for changing traffic patterns on SR 144.

#### **Little Pioneers Preschool Enrollment Now Open**
