



ILEARN Results

Parents of students in grades 3-8 as well as students who took high school biology this spring have been sent an email with their child's ILEARN assessment results. Please check your email soon to verify you received the information.

If you have a concern about your student's results or wish to view your child's responses to openended questions (there is no online portal for parents to access this information), please contact your child's school right away.

Parents have an opportunity to review and/or request a rescore for any eligible open-ended item(s) which students responded to on the ILEARN assessment, but rescore requests must be received by the state by Friday, June 3.

Families who are interested in participating in this process must come to school to view student's responses and request any rescores. Remote or virtual meetings to share or discuss test content are not allowed.




