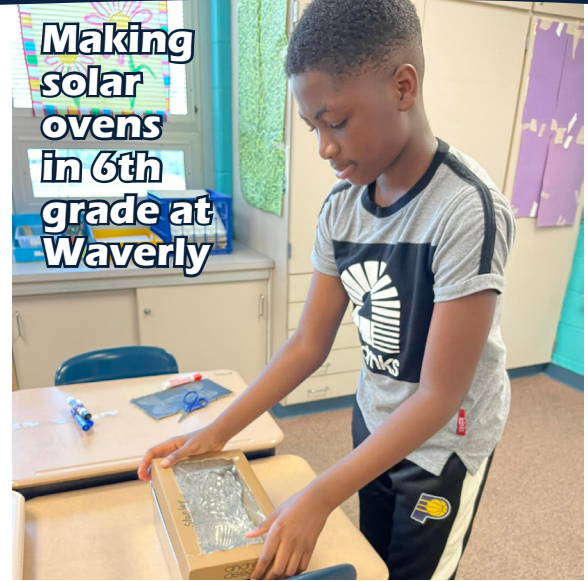

Pick-up is between 5:30 - 6:00pm.

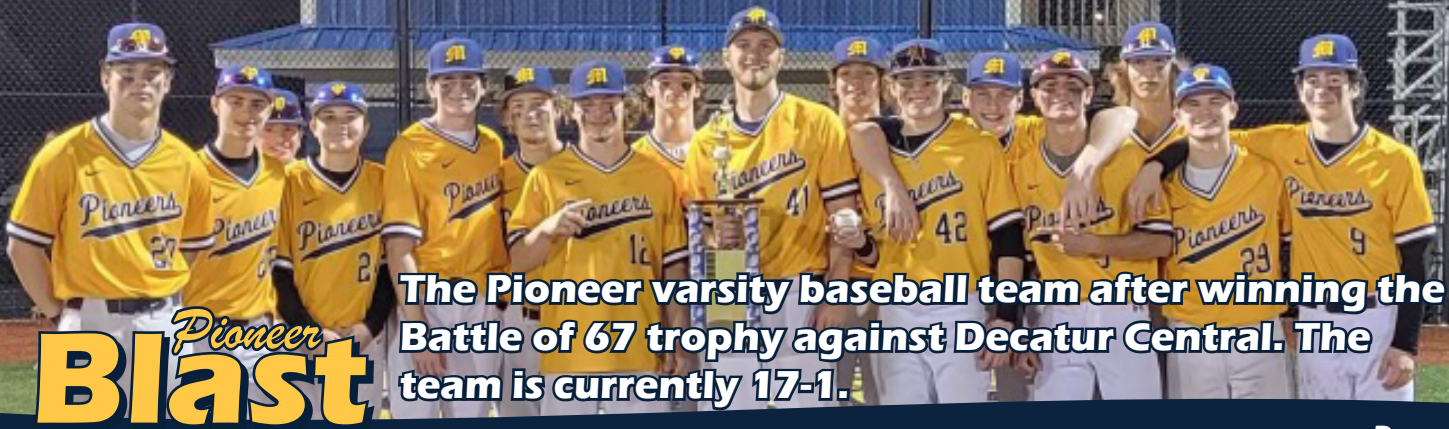
Half Day Programming hours are 12:00pm - 6:00pm.

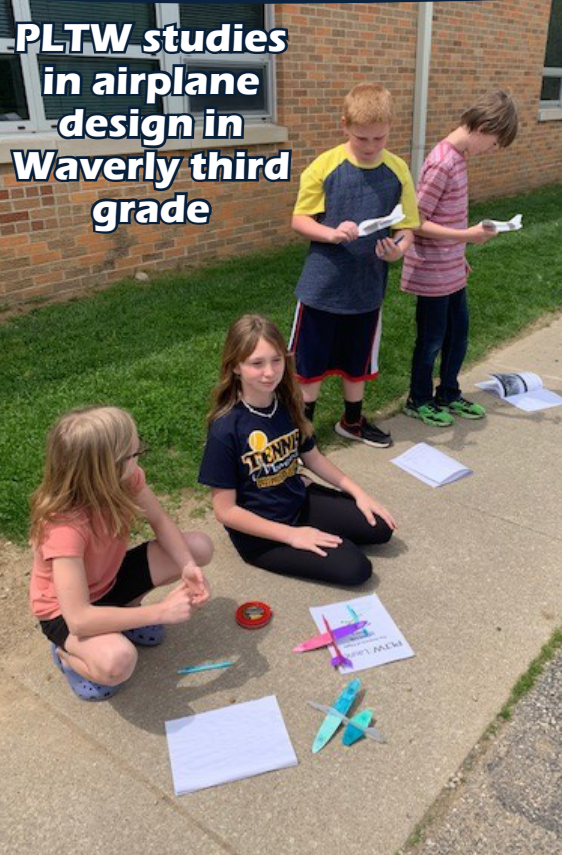

They will not be sent home with students. The tests are marked to expire in July or August 2022, but that date will likely be extended. Please check the IDOH website to determine if the expiration date has been extended.
