Traffic Updates

Sidewalk and road improvements along Monroe St./SR 267 have begun from Main St. to just north of Carlisle St. (highlighted roadway on map). This area includes all of the roadway in front of Newby Elementary School.

Short sections of the road may be limited to one lane between 8a.m. -5p.m. weekdays from now through early November.

This overall project will improve safety in the area by providing better sidewalk and crosswalk spaces as well as improved lighting.

Please be especially alert for increased traffic, including buses and pedestrians, in this area during morning MHS, PHMS, and Newby drop off times (approx. 7:20a.m. to 8:45a.m.) and afternoon dismissal times (2:40-3:40p.m.).



Mooresville Schools will receive additional state funding in support of K-12 curricular materials for the 2023-2024 school year. Because of this, families will not be charged fees for textbooks, workbooks, or Chromebooks for the 2023-2024 school year.

Fees will still apply for courses that earn college credit, preschool courses, any lost or damaged materials, fees from previous school years, and extracurricular activities.
