

Tackling Online Safety for Families

Parents and students often share concerns with school administrators, officers, and staff about concerns of their children seeing inappropriate social media accounts and posts, text messages, or messages via gaming systems. While the majority of these posts are created outside of school hours and school property, they can create a significant disruption to the school day and in some cases violate school policy.

Students who see or learn about a message, page or post that is a concern should let a trusted adult know right away about the issue. They, their parents, and community members are welcome to report the issue to school administrators either directly or through the school's QuickTips reporting system (learn more about it on p. 3). School administrators and officers will do their best to resolve the situation, but additional help is needed.

Anyone who is on a social media channel and sees an inappropriate post should report the **Continued on p. 3**

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post or the page through the social media platform's reporting system. The more times a post or page is flagged, the more likely it will be reviewed by the platform quickly and a decision made.

Most importantly, those who are on the social media platform should not follow the channel or share the offensive content. Channels with fewer followers are not as likely to be found by others.

Mooresville Schools has an anonymous safety tip reporting system for students or community members to share school safety concerns. The online form includes a checkbox for the school affected, an area to report the concern, and an option to share photos or other files. These can be shared anonymously or there is an optional area to include contact information for follow-up communication.
